Dear Parents

I would like to thank all those who were able to make it to our St Patrick's Day Celebrations last Monday, 17th March. The liturgy in the morning featured many of the children reading beautifully and praying reverently and I was particularly impressed with the children's beautiful singing voices. This was followed by some visual arts activities in the classrooms, many of which are adorning notice boards or fridges at home I am sure. The picnic in the afternoon, at Parramatta Park, was full of fun and had a real community feel. Can I once again thank Mrs Judith Kerr and her committee of teachers for all the organisation and to Mrs Elly Benkovich who assisted by transporting equipment in her husband's ute. I would also like to thank those parents who assisted teachers with the packing up or the removal of rubbish from the grounds.

This week the **Quality Catholic School's Survey (QCS)** was sent to 60 families who were randomly chosen by Catholic Education, Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP). Parents are able to complete the survey on line or by using the hardcopy and envelope provided. The purpose of the survey, which is now in its third year, is to ascertain parent views on a number of features relating to the school. At the end of the survey period, which is **Thursday 27th March**, all responses will be posted to the survey company Insight SRC Pty Ltd based in Melbourne where they will be collated and analysed. Information will then be given to each school with regard to its strengths and areas for further development. **All individual responses will be kept strictly confidential and will not be identifiable to any member of CEDP or the school.** Can I appeal to all parents who have been randomly selected to take a little time out of their day, (approx. 30mins) to complete the survey. The closer we are to 100% response the more accurate the summary. The Quality Catholic Schools survey will also be completed by the following groups: all school staff working in the CEDP, and children from years 5 and 6 and older.

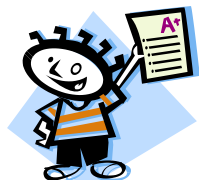
BOOK COVERING APPEAL

YEAR ONE FIREFIGHTERS VISIT

This term, Year One is learning about workers in the community who help us.

We were all very lucky to have fire fighters from the Parramatta Fire Station take time out of their busy day to visit our school.

They told us about some of the very special work they do like saving animals from high places, cleaning up dangerous chemical spills, going to serious car accidents to get people trapped in their cars, installing smoke alarms for the elderly and most of all going to fires, making sure everyone is safe and the fire is out. We helped the fire fighters to order safe and unsafe fire situations like it is safe to be near the barbecue, open fire, stove and oven if your parents are around, but unsafe if they are not.

We saw and discussed all the equipment the fire fighters use to help us and to keep us and them safe like metal cutters, chainsaws, torches, oxygen tank and mask, hoses, protective helmet and visor, fire coat and boots, walkie talkie and last of all a device that helps the fire fighters see in the dark so they can find us through the smoke.

We practiced dialling 000, get down low and go go go and stop, drop and roll.

We all had a great and educational time

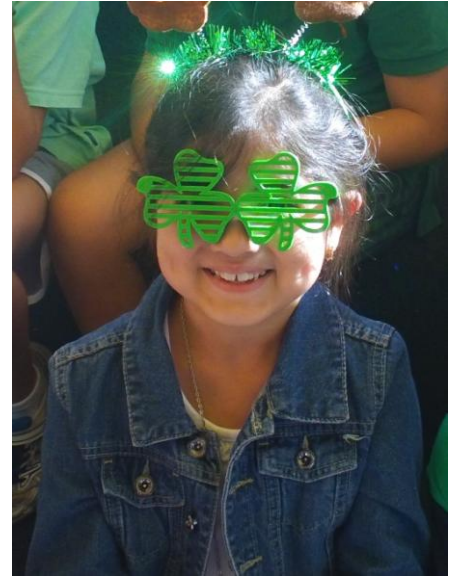

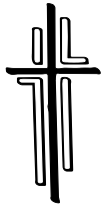
