- Joining the world of dream and fantasy to the everyday world

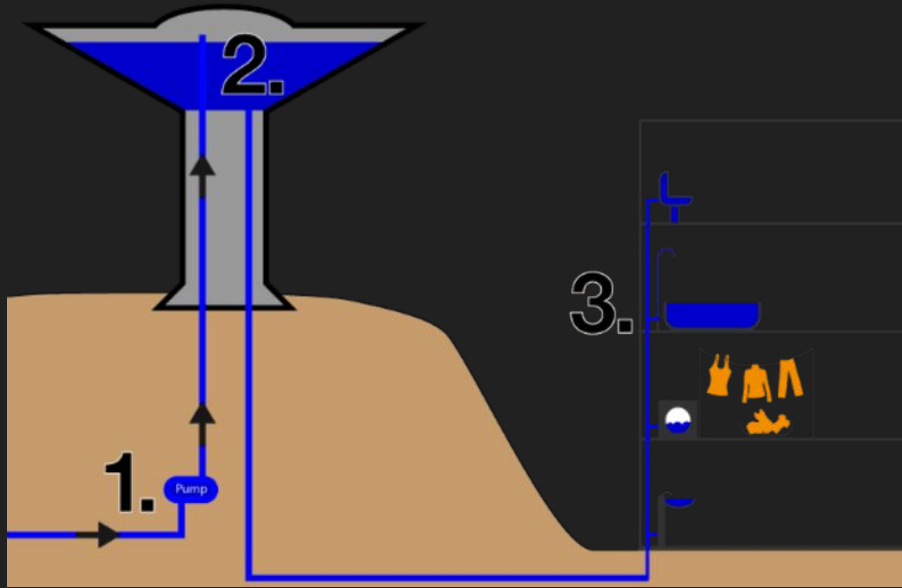
