If you want to **colour on this doc** then:

- **Highlight the cell** you want to colour.
- Go to **Format**
- Then scroll down to **Table**
- Select **Table properties** (it is at the bottom of the list)
- Choose **Cell background colour**

If you need some help to get started:

- Remember the flag is one whole flag divided into 10 equal pieces.
Look at each colour. How many pieces have you coloured? Write this as a fraction with a denominator of 10. Make sure you know what number you will use as your numerator. Now write this fraction as a decimal.
