Distance: 8,9 & 10yr olds = 2km 11,12 & 13yr olds = 3km

Note: Please ensure your child is able to complete the required running distance <u>without stopping for a break</u> before deciding if they should enter this event. Some students may need to practise to get a better understanding of just how difficult this event can be.

Term 1 2021 Statements have now been mailed to all families. Due date for payment of Term 1 fees is on or before **Wednesday 17th March 2021.** 

The Catholic Education Office Flexible Payment Plan Bpoint or Bpay is offered as a convenient option for payment of 2021 fees. The information required for the Flexible Payment Plan is included in the Instalment 1 statement.

### BPOINT & BPAY

If you would like to accept this offer please complete the Flexible Payment Direct Debit eForm (Bpoint) by visiting <u>https://www.parra.catholic.edu.au/fpp</u>. If an eForm has not been received prior to the payment due date the Catholic Education Office will assume you do not wish to take up the flexible payment option plan and you will be paying the Term 1 school fees by the 17th March 2021. **BPAY** election requires you to set this up via your bank account by 16th March 2021 so the first payment occurs on 17th March 2021.

#### How to help your child manage their online time

#### Stay engaged and encourage balance

- Keep an eye on the games, apps and devices your child uses. Chat with your child regularly and help them stay aware of how much time they are spending on different online and offline activities.
- Include positive things outside the online world in your conversations, such as what they love in life, careers they are interested in and new hobbies.
- Join in. Play games together as a family, or explore some joint online projects. Rather than being just a solitary activity, online time can then become another way of strengthening connections as well as building social skills.
- Where possible, avoid limiting online time as a punishment as this approach may inflate its importance to children.
